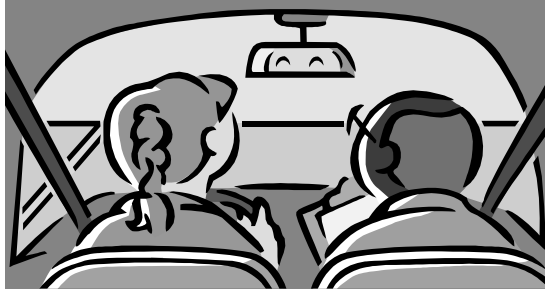
Who are We?

The central office retains administrative responsibility for all operations, shares supervision of branch staff and services and processes all claims.
