Flexible Scheduling-You will be able to schedule your own day, fitting in patient visits, documentation, and phone calls all while working it into the schedule that fits your life.

New Point of Service Laptops-You will be a part of the beginning of electronic documentation. This exciting change at NWHC will allow easier, faster documentation with increased integration of services.

Easy Access to Coworker Input – We have a small, close knit group of therapists. It is easy to discuss cases with other therapists as needed. Need for Specialized Interests – The field of home health is rapidly changing to “Pay for Performance” which is a payment system based on outcomes. We will be scored on several different outcome areas including wounds, incontinence, transfer and ambulation. We welcome specialized interests in these areas to help our team improve our outcomes.

Mentoring – You will be given ample orientation and one on one time with a current therapist. There will be abundant support and encouragement from the rehab services team.

Varied Diagnoses – You will have a variety of patient diagnoses to work with, always keeping your day varied and interesting. Some recent diagnoses have been: amputation, cancer, neurological diseases (Parkinson’s, MS, ALS, stroke), total joint replacements and fractures, cardiovascular disease.

One on One – You will have the rare opportunity in PT to work one on one with your patients. You are allowed ample time at each visit and won’t have the pressure of additional patients waiting for you in the waiting area.

Larger Entity – NWHC is part of the larger Luther Midelfort and Mayo Health System allowing you access to many specialty therapists to ask questions of and get ideas from, as well as many other resources.

Team Approach – You will be able to work with an interdisciplinary team including PT/OT/ST, nurses, social workers, pastoral care, home health aides, massage therapy and dietitians. You can be assured that there are many resources to help you at NWHC.
